Advanced Graphite Rod Construction Another important feature of an excellent redfish rod is its ability to sense even the slightest disturbance on the line. It could be a small redfish taking a bite! This means that a good redfish rod needs to be made out of the most sensitivity in mind. You'd hate to lose out on catching a redfish because you didn't feel it take your lure! Many rods today also incorporate a hybrid construction and utilize both fiberglass and graphite together. This gives the anglers a great blend of flexibility from the fiberglass and sensitivity and strength from the graphite. All the surf fishing rods we reviewed had a minimum length of 10 feet with some going up to 12 feet. The longer length also helps when battling a large redfish as the longer rods allow you to put more pressure on the fish and drag it up onto the beach. If you are fishing from a boat in areas like marshes and estuaries or the flats, you can go much shorter on rod length, and run a rod in the 8-foot range with no issues. Some anglers even prefer rods shorter than 8 feet, and you can find inshore rods that work well for redfish fishing. Redfish are often caught by casting lures and bait for long periods of time, which can be very uncomfortable if the grip doesn't fit your hand. Having a well-designed ergonomic grip alleviates the pressure put on your hand from casting, and allows redfish fishermen to fish for a very long time. Cork is very popular and lasts forever, it also doesn't absorb much in terms of water, and when it does it dries out quickly, EVA foam is super comfortable, but can soak up water like a sponge. At the end of the day, these are still both great options.
